The official repeater for CDXA is 147.78 - 147.18, located at the Holiday Inn adjacent to Carowinds (S.C.). The elevation of the antenna is 140 feet off the ground. The repeater is a Maggiore Hi-Pro and the duplexer is also manufactured by Maggiore. The amplifier is a 100-watt Lunar, specially designed for heavy use. The antenna is a Hustler, G-7. Our thanks go out to Hugh Campbell (N4AXT) and Mike Jackson (N4AYO) for donating the Lunar amplifier and a 35 amp power supply to CDXA. There are no special operating characteristics about the repeater. It's a 24-hour machine. Proper operating procedures are required. Please pause for breakers.
