UNJAMMING CDE ROTATORS

Has your rotator ever refused to turn the antenna? If so you are in good company. The problem is that sometimes the solenoid is unable to retract the brake wedge. Usually if you flip the motor switch one way or the other, the wedge brakes free. This may not work if the rotator is at one of the limits, because the switches inside the rotator prevent turning further into the limit. You can bypass the switches by jumpering terminals at the back of the control box, 5 to 8 for clockwise and 4 to 6 for counterclockwise. This will work for CDE Models Ham-M thru Ham IV.
