DX and QSL INFORMATION

RI8C(oblant 049) via bx 88--FB8 is now FT8-SV0AC/SV9 via WA4GCP--KX6PO via W4FRU up to 31 Dec 83--CT2CQ,CT2EF via W4PKM--W4PKM was CT2BB for 6 yrs and still has QSLs--K4IIF(CQ MAG) operated as XE1IF 27-28 Oct 84 via XE1XF--TT8CW via F6GXB ex J28CE. The other op is F6AJN ex J28CB & FB8ZQ. Note, FB8ZQ will be in TT8 for another 2 months and he was part of the trip to Clipperton last time that was cancelled. The cancelled group consisted of the following: K3NA, KK6X, N6BLN, W6OAT, W6RGG, W6SZN, W6TPH, N7NG, F6GXB, F9LX, DJ9ZB, FO8GW, FO8HL & FO8IW. The next attempt will be 27 Mar to 19 Apr, 85

Reservations has been arranged aboard the Royal Polaris. It has a length of 113', a 29' beam and driven by three V-12 diesels.

The owner, Frank LoPrests, must have a minimum of \$90,000.00 to cover expenses and profit before he leaves San Diego. The majority of the cost will be from fishermen who normally fill the 30 slots to the island.

The boat Phillippa on the cancelled trip cost \$37,000.00 The total was to be paid by the operators. This time they will be required to pay close to 3K each. Plus all other expenses to and from San Diego. The DX ops will need a sock full to cover cost.
