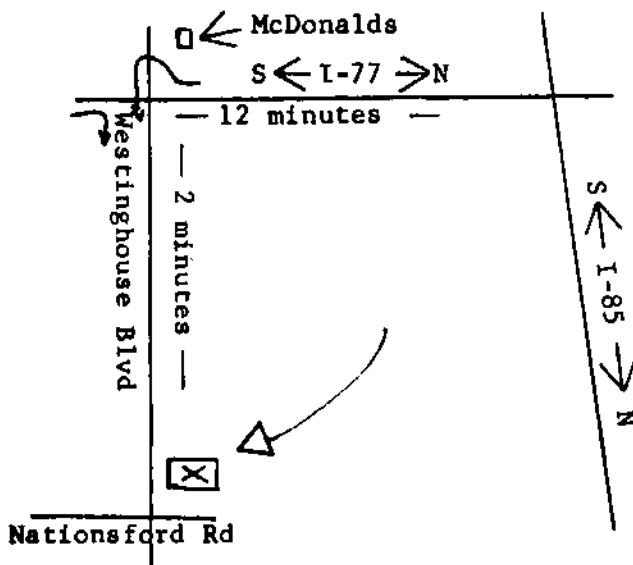

C Q W W CONTEST:

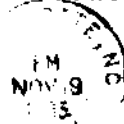
