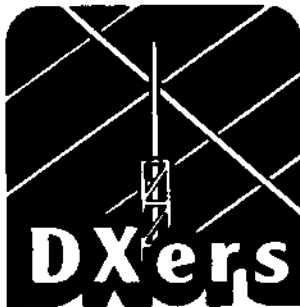

FCC REPORT::: Application for Amateur Radio Station and/or Operator License. As of 1 Jan 1986, only 610 forms dated June 1984 or later will be acceptable. If an older form is used, your application will be returned without action and you will be required to refile on a current form.... STILL ON AM?:::On 15 Oct, the U.S. Court of Appeals upheld the decision by the FCC on the 1500 watt rule. This shall apply to all AM operators effective 1 Jun 1990. The AMers are allowed 3000 watts until then. U.S. MARSHAL'S SERVICE AT WORK::: On Oct 8th & 17th they seized \$40,000.00 worth of illegal radio amplifiers and modified CB transceivers from two Northern California CB sales outlets. They being DOC HOLIDAY COMM in Santa Clara and RED MONKEY COMM in Fresno.
